



Leads complete this practice together or on their own. Always play both bowls on the same hand.

1. 4 ends rolling 2 jacks each. The first jack rolled determines the length for the next rolls.
2. Play 2 bowl singles with other leads. Score shots, first to 10 shots wins.
3. Place an opposition bowl close to the jack and play 2 bowls aiming to draw a close 2<sup>nd</sup> shot. The Lead's role here is to get one bowl within  $\frac{1}{2}$  mat of the jack, not trying to move the bowl or jack. Play 10 ends.
4. Finish by practicing perfect leading. Play 2 bowls, first bowl finishes  $\frac{1}{2}$  mat short and second bowl finishes 1 mat behind. Play 10 ends.
